MEDIA ACCREDITATION PROCEDURE

APPLYING FOR MEDIA ACCREDITATION

The World Arabian Horse Championship Press Office must be satisfied that anyone applying for media accreditation is a professional journalist and represents bona fide media formally registered as a media organization. The World Arabian Horse Championship Press Office reserves the right to request supplementary documentary evidence to be able to establish the status of applicants. Applications are considered on a case-by-case basis and the decisions of the World Arabian Horse Championship Press Office are final.

No media badge will be issued to journalists whose application does not conform to the established procedure.

Each journalist must submit an individual application and is requested to complete the Accreditation Form in its entirety. The Form must be returned with all the following documents:

- ➔ A photocopy of a press card valid for at least six months from the date of the event;
- ➔ A copy of passport
- ➔ Copies or links to articles within the last 6 months, for which the journalist is credited, may also be requested by the World Arabian Horse Championship Press Office.
- ➔ An official letter on letterhead from the editor-in-chief or head of your media organization mandating you to cover the World Arabian Horse Championship and specifying the number, names and precise duties of each person on the team.

Each accompanying staff member (sound engineers, cameramen, support staff, etc.) must also complete a separate Accreditation Form. If your team is composed of editorial journalists (print coverage) and audiovisual journalists (audiovisual coverage), please proceed in two steps and make two separate requests per main activity (editorial group and audiovisual group).

For all new medias, please send

- Media Print = A recent copy of the publication (PDF file) as well as 3 recent press clippings dedicated to horses and/or culture and illustrated by your photos (PDF file).

- Media Web = A link to the homepage of the site as well as several direct links to publications dedicated to horses and/or culture and illustrated by your photos.

Photographers must have a special insurance for professional risks which includes civil liability (certificate to be produced) and sign a discharge form

ELIGIBILITY FOR MEDIA ACCREDITATION

Media accreditation may be granted only to the editorial staff of publications/news wire services, press photographers and TV/radio crews representing a recognized media organization that is:

- ➔ newspapers/magazines - available to the general public, published at least 6 times a year by an organization whose principle business activity is publishing;

- online 'publications'- generating a substantial amount of original news content and which belongs to a registered media company with a verifiable non-web address plus telephone number;
- news wire services - providing news coverage to subscribers, including newspapers, periodicals and/or televisions;
- broadcast - broadcasting news and information programs to the general public either through satellite or terrestrial means.
- Photographers agree to send twelve royalty-free photos to the organization. The photo credit will of course be specified for any publication.

Freelance journalists including photographers, must provide clear evidence they are on assignment from a specific news organization or publication. A valid assignment letter from that news organization, or publication, is required.

Only complete accreditation will be examined.

The press photographer accreditation does not offer a place in the VIP area

Communications agencies will not be accepted for accreditation. They are dependent on a different channel.

It should be noted that no double accreditation will be allowed (e.g. as press and VIP guest).

It should be noted that no professional equipment (e.g. camera, drone, etc.) will be accepted in the VIP area if it does not have been declared in the form and approved by the World Arabian Horse Championship Press Office. (and this only during periods which will be specified to you at your arrival)

On your arrival, you will be asked to sign an internal regulation to which you will have to conform and a discharge.

It should be noted that a proper dress will be required for all accredited journalists.
